The Russians Are Coming

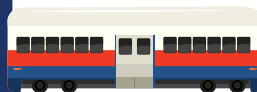
It wouldn't be a Reagan-era spy show without Soviet-sponsored, vodka-swilling bad guys and gals lurking around every corner.
